Continue with:

https://www.topmarks.co.uk/english-games/3-5-years/letters- and-sounds	 Show children pictures of the coast, beach, seaside etc. Children to write what they can hear, smell, see, taste and touch.
There are some phonics sheets and activities in the EYFS Home Learning pack. Tricky words he, she, me, be and we.	I can hear the waves. I can see the playground. I can smell fish and chips. I can taste ice cream. I can touch the sand.
	If able children write the whole sentence for each one or you can support by writing the beginning of each sentence. If you would like to extend your child they could add some describing words for example I can touch the soft sand.

Learning project for this week: Seaside To continue with the Ocean themed homework from last week and to link with The Snail and the Whale.

- Write a list of things you would need to take to the beach?
- Design an outfit you could wear to the beach.
- Can you make a boat from any empty containers you have got at home? Does it float? How many 10p piece can you put in it before it sinks?

- Seaside background cut and stick activity.
