Sadly, some books have been returned to school damaged, with pages torn in some and water damage in others.

We understand that accidents can happen and that water bottles are prone to leaking. We therefore kindly ask that water bottles are not stored in book bags to prevent water damage occurring in the future. Please note that a £5:00 charge will be issued to parents when books are returned to school in a damaged condition.

I would also like to remind parents that earrings are not allowed in school. Clear stud earrings can be worn to prevent piercings from closing. We appreciate your support in helping children follow this school rule.
